## **Core Fulbright U.S. Scholar Program (2-12 months)**

- Eligibilities
  - Haven't received a Fulbright Scholar grant for the last two years
  - US citizenship
  - Ph.D. or equivalent professional/terminal degree as appropriate
  - Foreign language proficiency as specified in the award description
- Applications (August 1 Deadline)
  - Teaching Awards, Research Awards, & Teaching Research awards
  - Application package includes: online application form, project statement, CV, syllabi (teaching), reference letters, letter of invitation, language proficiency, & supplemental materials
- Professional Qualifications
  - Credentials, training and professional standing.
  - Professional excellence, as evidenced through the quality of publications, grants, fellowships, honors, awards, conference papers, exhibitions, compositions, and performances.
  - Record of service to the field and the home institution.
- **Fulbright Global Scholar Award (3-6 months)**
  - Research or combined teaching/research activity in two to three countries with flexible schedule options
  - Total of 3-6 months with a minimum of one month spent in each host country within one academic year or spread over two consecutive years.
- **Fulbright Distinguished Chair Awards (3-12 months)**
  - Forty distinguished lecturing, distinguished research and distinguished lecturing/research awards
  - Eminent scholars with a significant publication and teaching record
- **Fulbright Postdoctoral Scholar Awards (3-20 months)**
  - Recent recipient of a doctoral degree within the five previous years or receiving by February 1, 2018

- Serves as expert consultants on curriculum, faculty development, institutional planning, and related subjects at academic institutions abroad
- Eligibilities
  - US citizenship
  - Must have significant experience in their respective fields
- Eligible disciplines:

- Application Process
  - Submit application to join the “Specialist Roster” (rolling basis)
  - Matched to a host institution project at some point during a 3-year tenure

- Eligibilities – See Core program
- Application includes project statement, your institutional statement, CV, and 3 reference letters.
